### Transportation:

- Due to public safety concerns related to COVID-19, your American Cancer Society is not currently setting up or coordinating patient rides to cancer-related appointments.

- Each Hope Lodge offers cancer patients and their caregivers a free place to stay when their best hope for effective treatment may be in another city.
- Hope Lodge provides a nurturing, home-like environment where guests can retreat to private rooms or connect with others. Every Hope Lodge also offers a variety of resources and information about cancer and how best to fight the disease

### Lodging:

- In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, ACS suspended Hope Lodge operations on March 27, 2020, because we could no longer ensure the health and safety of our immune-compromised cancer patient residents, volunteers, and staff.
- Rides Saves Lives: Transportation shouldn't be a roadblock to cancer treatment. We have several transportation assistance programs all across the country and can connect you to the best option for your situation.
- Road to Recovery Eligibility: Depending on your individual needs and what's available in your area, we may be able to coordinate a ride with an American Cancer Society volunteer driver. Patients must be traveling to a cancer-related medical appointment.
- Other eligibility requirements may apply. For example, a caregiver may need to accompany a patient who cannot walk without help, or is under age 18. Contact us to find out what is available in your area, and what the specific requirements are.
- It can take several business days to coordinate your ride, so please call us at 1-800-227-2345 well in advance of your appointment date.
